



**Summary:** Manufactured in 1964 to commemorate the birth of Colt Manufacturing, comes with a Colt Archives Letter, Original Walnut Factory wood display case that shows fair wear for its age, a nicked plaque on the cover reading "ONE OF 5000 COLONEL SAML COLT SESQUICENTENNIAL MODEL 1814-1964, "The Arms Collection of Colonel Colt" by R.L Wilson, 12 Nickel dummy rounds.

Nickel finished cylinder, grip straps, and ejector. Assembly, Special unfluted cylinder with engraved vines and chiseled bored inscribed 1814-1964, cased in a red velvet-lined case and cartage clock for 12 rounds of special nickel-plated display cartridges.
