A commissioned work of art by the famous FEGA Master Engraver by Mitch Moschetti. Presented on a 1972 Colt Combat Commander 1911 chambered in 9mm.

When FEGA established their Profession certification in 1985 Mitch was the youngest member awarded that status.

Mitch's specialty is captivating three-dimensional style carving which he calls flying leaf and vine.

This masterpiece is no exception. The deep carving and cross hatching pop at you in spectacular ways while bounced off different shades and positions of lighting and displaying.

Mitch has been published in many Colt and Engraving magazines and books including in the American Engravers III by C. Rogers Bleile.
