



Summary:

A commissioned work of art by the famous Master Engraver by Thierry Duguet. Presented on a 1978 Colt Python with 6" barrel chambered in 357mag.

Born in France, trained in Belgium, a graduate from the prestigious gunsmith and engraver's school, L'école d'armurerie Léon Mignon, in Liège, Belgium.

Thierry's work has been showcased around the world. An apprentice of the late Mastery Engravers such as René Delcour and Philippe Grifnée of Holland and Holland. Inspired by Master Engravers such as Italy's Firmo Fracassi (known as the Renaissance Man), Thierry has perfected his signature of carving which he calls "arboreal deep relief" which he depicts in various styles.

This masterpiece is no exception. A heirloom full coverage Grade D deep carving and cross hatching completed and black filled keep the best contrast against the original Satin Stainless Finish.

Thierry has been published in many Colt and Engraving magazines and books including in the American Engravers III by C. Rogers Bleile.

This is a rare your opportunity to own apart of modern day art on a historic Colt Collectable that will last for eternity.
