The principle of Yin and Yang from Chinese philosophy is that all things exist as inseparable and contradictory opposites.

# In Chinese philosophy

Yin =**Tiger**= wind, rain, earth

Yang = **Dragon** = water, sky, heavens

Together they create a dynamic system where the whole becomes greater than its parts.

Yin = left = female = tiger

Yang = right = male = dragon

Together these two can keep the universe balanced.

Incorporating the black and white theme:

## Wind and Rain-

The **White Tiger** prowls through the bamboo forest, dealing with a diagonal rainfall and wind blowing around her.

# Sky and Water-

The **Black Dragon** flies across the sky moving amongst and through the clouds above the water. The clouds swirl around his body.

# Right sides-

The Tiger and Dragon both come right up to and over the edges onto the top and underneath the frame.

Incorporating the pin on the right side of the firearm, making it part of the design. The Dragon is holding its orb.

## Left sides-

Represent classic Japanese Mount Fuji pulling the pair together.

Japan adopted the Yin Yang philosophy, which originates from Chinese culture



The left side design of the Tiger --

A hillside and pagoda looking across to the mountain from land.

The left side design of the Dragon --

The sea moves across the foreground of the scene, the far-off mountain peaks out from the curls of a giant wave.

Selective mirror images, matching them with the right side.

Carved and 24k Gold inlay around the Rampant Colt Stamp without compromising its symbolism, on each.
