Mitch's specialty is captivating three-dimensional style carving which he calls flying leaf and vine.

This masterpiece is no exception. A One of One production with level C coverage. The deep carving and cross hatching pop at you in spectacular ways while bounced off different shades and positions of lighting and displaying.

Shaded areas are found on the slide giving more depth perception of this hand engraved work of art.

Mitch has been published in many Colt and Engraving magazines and books including in the American Engravers III by C. Rogers Bleile.
